1. Describe the relationship of Galatians to Romans. (3 marks)
2. Why was the epistle to the Romans written? Give three reasons. (3 marks)
3. Show the importance of the Book of Galatians. Explain four areas. (6 marks)
4. Explain your understanding of the following terms:
 - a. “Self-indulgent sinners”. (2 marks)
 - b. “Self-righteous sinners”. (2 marks)
5. Identify two theories regarding the date and setting of Galatians, and give support of each theory. (8 marks)
6. State and explain three things that make the Book of Romans unique. (6 marks)

Section B: (30 marks)

Answer TWO questions in this section. Question 1 is compulsory.

1. Read Romans 1:20-31 and describe Paul’s teaching and the human beings as they are today. Give three chief points that Paul makes in his teaching. Show whether the basic problem is human sins and ignorance or people’s refusal to honor and be thankful to Him (15 marks)
2. Identify five parallels between Romans and Galatians. Cite Scriptural references to confirm the parallelism. (15 marks)
3. Explore the Law in the Book of Galatians. In your exploration, explain three functions of the Law in Galatians (15 marks)
4. Paul discusses four main arguments in Galatians 3:1-4:11. Identify any three arguments and explain them in detail. (15 marks)
