1. Preaching is a core ministry of the Church:
 - (a) Explain FIVE reasons why good preaching is important to the church today. (10 marks).
 - (b) Explain TWO similarities and THREE differences between preaching and teaching. (10 marks).
 - (c) Identify FIVE qualities of an effective preacher and how they affect the life and ministry of the church and community. (10 marks).

2. Effective Church ministry requires knowledge of biblical content and the appropriate methods to communicate it.
 - (a) Comment briefly on this statement: “Knowing what to preach on is one thing while preaching is another thing. (5 marks).
 - (b) State and discuss TEN elements that are necessary to consider in communicating the gospel effectively to an audience or congregation. (10 marks).

 - (a) Explain FIVE characteristics that distinguish textual sermon from topical sermon. (5 marks).
 - (b) A preacher once preached a sermon on ‘GOD’S LOVE.’ Discuss TEN principles that this preacher might have followed in order to come up with such a topic for his sermon. (10 marks).

 - (a) State FOUR strengths and ONE weakness of expository sermon (5 marks).
 - (b) Prepare an expository sermon based on the book of Philemon (10 marks)
5. Structuring a sermon is a skill that all preachers should learn:

- (b) Identify and discuss FIVE main elements that characterize a good conclusion in a sermon. (5 marks).
- (c) Explain FIVE things a preacher should avoid while concluding his or her a sermon. (5 marks).
