Section One: This section is compulsory (20mks)

1. Give your responses to the following areas as relate to family and ministry (20mks)
 - (i) A Church has refused to ordain her pastor because he is not married. Give your FIVE views that argue for or against the Church's decision (5mks).
 - (ii) Discuss FIVE insights you can learn from Gen 2:24 "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh" (5mks)
 - (iii) Explain in FIVE different ways why the words of Joshua: "But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord" (Josh 24:15) is fundamental for the success of our Christian families and ministries today (5mks).
 - (iv) Paul posits: "Therefore I do not run aimlessly, I do not fight like one beating the air..." (I Cor 9:26). Discuss FIVE essential disciplines that a good minister of the gospel should embrace in order to be successful both in the family and ministry (5mks).

2. In a recent study in one of the local universities in Africa, it was discovered that there is a very serious drop in enrollment of students in school of Divinity and Theology (10mks)
 - (i) Discuss with FIVE possible reasons why there is a drop of enrollment in this particular school while other schools in the same University are receiving three or four times more of enrollments (5mks)
 - (ii) Explain FIVE strategies that this University need to adopt in order to increase the enrollment of students in its school of Divinity and Theology (5mks)
3. Children are a blessing from the Lord but a Christian marriage is still considered complete whether they are there or not (10mks)
 - (i) Discuss FIVE ways on how childlessness is viewed in your cultural context (5mks)

- (ii) Discuss FIVE ways on how the Church should respond to this issue of childlessness that is facing couples especially those serving in the ministry today (5mks)
