SECTION A: Compulsory Questions (20 Marks)

1. Present theological statements for the personality and divinity of the Holy Spirit, giving Scriptural references to support every case in your proposition. (5 Marks)
2. Describe the difficulties inherent in understanding the Holy Spirit, and give reasons in support to the necessity for the study of the doctrine of the Holy Spirit today. (5 Marks).
3. We argued in class that the doctrine of the Holy Spirit is not a New Testament phenomenon, but a Canonical one. Examine the following Old Testament text, Num 11: 29, Jeremiah 31:31-34, Ezekiel 36:25-27 and Joel 2:28-29, and clearly delineate the significance of these expectations as fulfilled through Christ. (10Marks)

SECTION B: Answer any two Questions (ONLY) in this Section (20 Marks)

1. Exegete 1 Corinthians 12 and 13, and draw sound principles regarding the administration of spiritual gifts in your local Church. (10 Marks)
2. Millard Erickson argues that the Church interest in the Holy Spirit underwent a long period of decline during the 18th and 19th centuries due to a variety of movements which regarded the Holy Spirit work as either superfluous or incredible. Discuss these movements and evaluate their effects to the doctrine of Pneumatology to date. (10 Marks).
3. What difference would it make whether or not Jesus is divine and "the Anointed one" to each of these fundamentals in the Christian faith: theology, morality and liturgy? (10 Marks).
4. Based on our course text and the discussion in class, describe Pauline spirituality of the Cross – Cruciformity as the paradigm for the Spirit-filled life of believers in Christ. (10 Marks)
