1. (a) Provide the meaning of the following terms: *Mission and Missions* **(2mks)**
(b) Outline FIVE reasons why according to Eph 1:3-14 Missions to the world is NOT an optional to a Christian today **(5mks)**.
(c) State THREE specific ways in which the 'missionary call' today is similar to Abraham's call in the Bible **(3mks)**
2. (a) With the help of some scriptures explain very briefly FOUR areas that point to Jesus as our great example in doing God's mission on earth. Which one of the four areas mentioned has been most impacting to your life and ministry in the recent past? Explain **(10mks)**.
(b) Identify FIVE elements that are considered to be part of the mission of the Church and FIVE elements that are not considered to be part of the mission of the church **(10mks)**.

3. Paul is considered to have played a very significant role as far as the mission work is concerned among the Gentiles.
(a) Describe FIVE strategies that Paul used in providing an effective mission work among the Gentiles **(5mks)**.
(b) Discuss FIVE "myths" about missions that have hindered some Christians from active participation in Missions today. What strategies should Evangelical Christians employ in order to overcome challenges and "myths" that hinder them in doing missions today? **(10mks)**.
4. (a) Describe FIVE problems that characterize the world today in which God has called us to do Missions. Which one best relates with the context in which you minister? **(5mks)**
(b) Despite many problems that characterize our today's world, mission work has been done with both good and wrong motives. Describe FOUR right motives and THREE wrong motives that characterize the way missions have been done today. What THREE practical lessons can we learn from these? **(10mks)**.
5. (a) What is a "missionary call"? Narrate FOUR common misunderstanding about a "missionary call" today **(5mks)**.
(b) Discuss SEVEN steps that you can use to guide someone in recognizing the "missionary call" of God is his or her life. What THREE "preparations" should such a potential missionary consider even as he or she positioned himself or herself in doing mission work? Give some biblical references **(10mks)**.
6. (a) What is a culture shock? Narrate your own story or that of someone you know who experienced this culture shock. What was your or his/her experience like? **(5mks)**.
(b) Describe FIVE causes of culture shock and how missionaries and other church workers should deal with it in their ministry among people of other cultures **(10mks)**.
