Characteristics	Help in Teaching
Physical: Much energy; active	
Mental: Increasing vocabulary, knowledge.	
Social: Hero worship: pattern their behavior after their heroes.	
Spiritual: Forming life-long habits	

3. State and explain any four levels of learning. (4 marks)

5. There are several characteristics of a good story which help us choose those stories that are most suitable in our teaching. State and explain any five characteristics. (5 marks)

3. Identify the value of visual aids and explain in detail their basic purposes. (10 marks)
4. Highlight and explain 5-P's factors that affect a teacher's good delivery. (10 marks)
