6. According to Whitesell (1949) what is the work of the Holy Spirit in a sinner? (2)
7. State two distinguishing marks that disciples of Christ are supposed to have. (1)
8. How can you show biblically discipleship is open to all people? (1)
9. What is the cost of discipleship as it relates to a believer's family (1)
