SECTION A: Answer ALL Questions TOTAL: 20 Marks

1. As we considered the exemplary life of Enoch amid a wicked culture in primeval history of the Book of Genesis, we asked the following applicational question: *What Does It Look Like to Walk With God Today* in the perilous times in which we presently live in the twenty-first century? How are we helped to answer this question from the New Testament letter to the Christians at Ephesus? 10 Marks
2. The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob is a promise-making and promise-keeping God! The Abrahamic Covenant speaks of both Messianic Vision and Missional Miracle! Having studied the lecture—*Abraham: The Friend of God*—how would you unpack and explain the significance and the magnificence of the Abrahamic covenant? 10 marks

SECTION A: Answer TWO QUESTIONS 20 Marks

1. Provide a brief overview of each book in the Pentateuch. What is the *key idea* of each book? Which particular aspect of God's *character* is seen in each book? How is God portrayed with respect to His *role* in each book? How would you summarize the *command* of God in each book?
2. Which particular Pentateuchal writing did the Lord Jesus Christ appeal to in the wilderness of temptation? Which passages did the Lord Jesus Christ quote from this particular Pentateuchal writing? Why is it especially significant, as has been suggested by one writer, that the Lord Jesus Christ appealed, when tempted, to this particular Pentateuchal writing?
3. Discuss Yahweh's call of Moses into ministry as seen in chapters 3 and 4 of the Book of Exodus. What were the objections of Moses? What were the corrections of Yahweh to the objections of Moses? How is the ministry of Moses summarized in the final chapter of the final book of the Pentateuch?
4. In our study of the Law we spoke in terms of the Moral-Ethical Law, The Civil Law, The Ceremonial-Ritual Law. Define these three categories, from a Pentateuchal perspective (especially with Exodus and Leviticus in view).
