SECTION A: Answer ALL questions

Joseph Bourke notes that ruach (the Hebrew word for 'spirit') also means 'wind' or 'breath'. The wind symbolism is particularly ancient. Demonstrate how this symbolism, though primitive, is carried on in Scripture in the New Testament. (10mks)

The outpouring of the Spirit on the Day of Pentecost is regarded as the final and most dramatic act of Christ in transferring his ministry to his disciples.

- a) List and briefly explain 5 evidences of baptism in the Holy Spirit. (5 mks)*
- b) Discuss two examples of a power encounter in the early church. Be sure to note whether a truth encounter also occurred in each instance. Give contextual examples to show the relevance for today. (10 mks)*
- c) Baptism in the Holy Spirit endows the believer with power. Explain how this power is released to bless and build the church. Give biblical examples. (5 mks)*

SECTION B: Answer ANY TWO questions

Demonstrate from Scripture that baptism in the Holy Spirit is both an immersion and an in-filling and that it is distinct from regeneration. Discuss how that impacts believers today. (15mks)

Acts 19:13-16 narrates the attempt by the seven sons of Sceva to exorcise an evil spirit. Although their father was a Jewish chief priest, the man with an evil spirit seized them and overpowered them all. Discuss their failure in regard to power ministry and what led to it. Identify how we can deal with such instances in our churches today. (15 mks)

Highlight and briefly explain five purposes of signs and wonders as seen in the New Testament and outline their implications for the church today. (15 mks)

Jesus promised to empower the Church to evangelize the world (Ac 1:8). This promise, fulfilled on the Day of Pentecost (Ac 2), makes power ministry possible. List and briefly discuss three reasons why the Church needs members who minister in the power of God. (15mks)
