5. Explain any four methods that Jesus used as the model for the principles that Coleman sets forth in his book, 'The Master and His Plan'. (2 marks)

1. In understanding discipleship, explain three things that focus primarily on the one-to-one form of disciple-making. Give scriptural references in each form of disciple-making. (10 marks)
2. There are eight core values of a disciple from God's Word. Discuss any five values and give scriptural reference of each. (10 marks)
3. Discuss in detail the role of the Holy Spirit and prayer in evangelism. How did the power of God manifested through the apostles in the Book of Acts. (10 marks)
4. Explain in detail five areas that you can model the Christian life. Give Scriptures and apply the message in your life and ministry. (10 marks)
