SECTION A: Answer ALL questions

- b) Evaluate the relevant practice of the global church today. (5 marks)

2. Discuss how the Old Testament mission of God as revealed in Genesis 12:1-3 and Isaiah 49:6 connects with the New Testament vision for evangelism and discipleship. Give two contextual examples to support your answers. (10 marks)

SECTION B: Answer ANY TWO questions

3. Examine how Jesus interaction with the Samaritan woman in John 4:7-26 provides evangelistic strategies that may be applied in modern contexts. Give two relevant examples to support your answers. (10 marks)

4. “The cross is God’s antidote to everything that oppresses and enslaves”. Discuss this assertion with regard to social action as an approach to evangelism and discipleship. Give two contextual examples to support your answers. (10 marks)

5. Compare and contrast the “go tell” and “come and see” approaches to evangelism and discipleship. Give biblical and contextual examples to support your arguments. (10 marks)

6. Discuss the significance of “closed sets and open sets” approach to church membership and its implications for evangelism and discipleship. Give biblical and contextual examples to support your answers. (10 marks)
