He also knows that in the house at fork live identical twin brothers whom he cannot tell apart. Both know the road to Kisumu. He knows that one brother always lies and the other always tells the truth. Give the single question that he can ask to whoever answers his knock on the door to help him find the correct road to Kisumu. Explain the reason for your answer. (10 marks).
