2. Work of the Holy Spirit in the Old Testament (7 Marks)
3. Prophecies of the work of the Holy Spirit in the Messiah (7 Marks)
4. The implications of the doctrine of the Holy Spirit (7 Marks)

PART TWO – Choose any two

1. Briefly discuss Jesus teaching concerning the Holy Spirit citing the key verses that cite his teaching. (Mark 6)
2. What evidence would you present to a new Christian to convince him that the Holy Spirit is a person. (Marks 6)
3. Compare and contrast tongues as a sign and tongues as a gift.
4. Evaluate the various interpretations of the phrase, “Born of water and Spirit” and support your conclusion regarding this issue. (6 Marks)

PART THREE – Attempt all

1. Examine the biblical passages dealing with the relationship between the work of the Spirit and the work of the Son. What implications does this carry for our experience? (Marks 15)
2. What application can you make concerning the Spirit’s ministry that emerge from the fact that he is depicted as Wind, Fire, Water, Oil. (Marks 15)
3. Differentiate the use of tongues as an initial evidence of baptism of the Holy Spirit from other uses of tongues mentioned in the New Testament. (15 Marks)
4. Evaluate the emphasis your church places on the Holy Spirit. How do you plan to use what you have learnt in this course in your church (Ministry). (15 Marks)
