1. What is your understanding of the word 'Apologetics'? (2 marks)
2. The definition of Christianity may be expressed in a general definition and in a specific definition. Use general definition to define 'Christianity'. (2 marks)
3. Read 1 Peter 3:15 and explain three things in this apologetic mandate. (4 marks)
4. State and explain the threefold task of apologetics. (6 marks)
5. The important question for Christian apologetics is what the place of Christian evidences is in Christian apologetics is. To answer this question, there are three alternatives. State and briefly explain these alternatives. (6 marks)
