2. The relationship of Christ to the Church is two-fold. Describe two ways that show this relationship and give Scriptural references. (4 marks)
3. Highlight three aspects of corporate eschatology and support your answer with Scriptural references. (6 marks)
4. State and explain two purposes of the Tribulation. (4 marks)
5. Explain your understanding of the following three views of the Millennium. (6 marks)
 - a. Amillennialism
 - b. Postmillennial
 - c. Premillennial
6. Describe the nature and observance of one of the ordinances. (2 marks)
