SECTION A: ANSWER ALL FOUR OF THE QUESTIONS IN THIS SECTION.
(EACH WORTH 5 MARKS)

1. Describe the relevance of orthodox, biblical doctrines in both the personal and vocational life of a Christian individual.
2. From a biblical perspective, explain why penal substitutionary atonement is the nucleus of what Jesus accomplished on the cross, compared to other components of salvation.
3. Critique the argument that anyone who claims to prophesy by the power of the Holy Spirit, or on the authority of angels, is speaking objective truth and should be obeyed without question. Use biblical passages and biblical examples of prophecy to support your answer.
4. Progressive theology of Christianity states that an unbeliever's acceptance by others into a Christian community is of higher priority than the individual making a commitment of faith (i.e., it is more important to welcome an unbeliever to be part a church than to encourage conversion). Evaluate this stance from a soteriological, ecclesiological and eschatological perspective.

Section B: ANSWER ANY TWO QUESTIONS (20 MARKS)

Create an orthodox, biblical teaching lesson for use in a church setting (i.e., Bible study, small group, etc.). The lesson should include a brief introduction of the category of Christian theology in question (e.g., *soteriology*), the main points of argument from a biblical perspective and a practical application component for Christian life.

5. Ecclesiology: Address the mission of the Church and how it is accomplished by Christian individuals within a local church setting. (10 marks)
6. Angelology: Address the nature and roles of angels and the Christian relationship with angels. (10 marks)
7. Eschatology: Address the events and significance of the return of Christ. (10 marks)
8. Pneumatology: Address the definition, acquisition and application of the baptism of the Holy Spirit. (10 marks)
