2. How has our present understanding of *ethnos* negatively affected our perception of evangelism. (2)
3. Why would the mandate of our Christian experience be a good motivator to believers for evangelism? (2)
4. Present Biblical support for the practical evangelism you did in this course. (1)
5. Show two Biblical cases of the Spirit guiding the Early Church in evangelism. (1)
6. According to Whitesell (1949) how does the Spirit work objectively and subjectively in sinners? (2)
7. Fruit as a mark of Christ's disciples has two aspects. Name them. (1)
8. Refute the argument that discipleship is a call only for special believers in Christ. (1)
9. From the perspective of Jesus what is the cost of discipleship in relationships? (1)
