4. Give any two facts that the Scripture says about the rapture in regards to the work of Christ. (2 marks)
5. Show why Christ's pre-existence is important. (2 marks)

1. Clearly explain what is meant by the Kenosis theory and give any **FOUR** valid reasons to support your position as concerns the theory.
2. Define the phrase "hypostatic union" and explain its implications to the Christian faith.
3. Why is Christ's resurrection crucial to the Christian faith? By giving **FOUR** evidences, prove that Christ resurrected from the dead.
4. Define the term "virgin birth" and briefly explain its importance.
5. Show that Jesus Christ born in Bethlehem of Judea was the expected Messiah of the Jews.
