 - a) Discuss the negative responses they are likely to experience (8 marks).
 - b) Explain what they should do with positive responses (2 marks)
2. Discuss the characteristics that should be evident in the lives of persons who need to disciple others in their spiritual growth (10 marks)

Section B: Answer 2 Questions only (20 marks)

3. The early church was very successful in evangelizing. Discuss how the following contributed to this success:
 - a) The Holy Spirit's sovereign actions (5 marks).
 - b) Believers' personal and corporate motivation (5 marks)
4. The objective of discipleship is to lead believers to maturity. Explain 5 characteristics of a mature Christian that you would want to achieve in those you disciple. Support your answer with contemporary examples (10 marks)

5. Your church is planning to carry out a campaign to encourage members of the congregation to be engaged in evangelism. As one of the speakers:

- a) Discuss why they should be engaged in evangelism (6 marks)
- b) Explain four practices that will encourage them in evangelism (4 marks)

6. Explain how the following people stand out as good examples of discipleship.

- a) Jesus (4marks)
- b) Paul (3 marks)
- c) Barnabas (3 marks)
