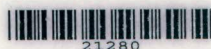

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the study is to find out what hinders spiritual growth and the role that leadership development through discipleship plays in enhancing spiritual growth at MHC. The aim is to use the results from the study to enhance and improve leadership of discipleship.

Data collection was gathered through questionnaires, analyses were done through list of tables and list of figures that had been gathered from the questionnaires. The presentation was done through pie charts and bar charts.

The research findings show that the congregation population has continued to grow steadily over the years. More than half of the congregants are new hence there is greater need of discipleship considering this steady rise in numbers this will ensure that the spiritual needs of the congregation are met. The findings reveal that there are more respondents attending Mamlaka Hill Chapel than there were 8 years ago, therefore the need for leadership in discipling the congregation.

Some of the key recommendations that proper leadership in follow-up and teaching, a local congregation such as MHC, can produce mature Christian leaders.
