**SECTION A: Answer ALL questions**

1. Effective youth programmes must incorporate elements of ministry and management:
  - a) Define what is meant by *ministry* and give an example to illustrate your answer. (3 marks)
  - b) State Anderson's definition of *management*. (2 marks)
  - c) Outline Berkley's management styles matrix and briefly describe the four different styles. (10 marks)
2. State and briefly explain *five* practices or disciplines that can ensure the youth worker has a healthy spiritual core. (10 marks)
3. List *five* aspects that a youth worker should consider in terms of financial management. (5 marks)

**SECTION B: Answer ANY TWO questions**

4. You have been appointed as the youth minister at Vineyard Church in Ruaka. You have been tasked with setting up the youth ministry.
  - a) Discuss how the aspects of *architecture* and *atmosphere* may help you in building a sustainable ministry. (2 marks)
  - b) With brief explanations of each, describe *four* elements that you need to consider in organizing your new office space. (8 marks)
  - c) Justify how an interdisciplinary methodology of designing your teaching curriculum can enrich your new youth ministry. (5 marks)
5. The church has been viewed by some as a *household of God*. As a household, two main perspectives proposed are the administrative and the spiritual aspects:
  - a) Use five examples from the Scriptures to explain the concept of management. (10 marks)
  - b) List five qualities of the good manager of God's household. (5 marks)
6. Imagine the following scenario: two youth leaders are arguing about how you should spend KES 20,000. One suggestion is to treat the youth leaders with a trip while the other is to buy small group study guides.
  - a. Expound on how the concept of *the leadership triangle* relates to this. (6 marks)
  - b. Define Christian leadership and describe three qualities of a good leader. (6 marks)
  - c. List three biblical views of team work. (3 marks)
7. It has been said that failing to plan is planning to fail:
  - a. List and explain five elements that should be considered in the planning of a youth ministry. (10 marks)
  - b. Using Covey's time management quadrant, justify the importance and urgency of the following four tasks - meeting with the senior pastor, preparation for a

camp that is in five months, deleting spam email and returning a phone call from your sister. (5 marks)
