SECTION A: Answer BOTH Questions

1. According to Samuel Waje Kunhiyop, “In the past, the Holy Spirit was often neglected in Christian thinking, but Pentecostalism has awakened the church to the reality of the Spirit’s role in our salvation and in our Christian life.” What are your thoughts on the statement above spoken by the esteemed African theologian, Samuel Waje Kunhiyop? (10 MARKS)

2. The Divine Son's three-year ministry—proclamation (Word) and demonstration (Deed)—was carried out in the power of the Holy Spirit. Jesus as the God-Man relied not on the prerogatives of His inherent indwelling deity but rather on the pneumatic power of the Third Person of the Holy Trinity (Luke 4:18; Acts 1:1-2; 2:22; 4:27; 10:38). Does it encourage you to read the various Scriptures in this lecture which speak of the empowering, the anointing, the energizing presence of the Holy Spirit in the life and ministry of the Lord Jesus Christ? How does it encourage you? Why does it encourage you? (10 MARKS)

SECTION B: Answer ANY TWO Questions

3. When we follow the words of Paul which he wrote in Galatians 5:16—Walk in the Spirit and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh—we will pursue, cultivate, and enjoy an ongoing wholistic and dynamic, empowering relationship with the indwelling Holy Spirit. Based on what you have learned about Galatians 5:16 in this section of the course, how would you explain the Spirit-led Christian walk? (10 MARKS)

4. Stanley Horton says, “Over most of the history of the Church there has been too much dependence on human resources. As long as the funds, equipment, [people], materials, and technical skill are available, projects are pushed with every expectation of success. Yet often

they fail in spite of everything.” What are your thoughts on this statement and what are your thoughts as to how Stanley Horton goes on to illustrate this statement? **(10 MARKS)**

5. LUKE 24:49 = ενδύω: This term literally means “I put on.” The term ενδύω / which occurs twenty seven times in the New Testament, speaks of the covering over of human frailty and being clothed or robed with divine power (e.g. Romans 13:12, 14; Ephesians 6:11, 14). The world of fashion asks Are you dressed for success? Based on the Greek term ενδύω—I put on — how would you respond to this question in both biblical manner and a practical manner? **(10 MARKS)**
