1. Define the following terms: (4 marks)

2. Man is unique in several ways. State and explain four ways that show that man is unique and no other creature can compare with him. (4 marks)
3. State and explain four things that cannot regenerate life. (4 marks)
4. What are the three results of conversion? (3 marks)
5. State and explain five practice truths from the image of God. Give Scriptural references where applicable. (5 marks)

Answer any TWO questions in this section.

1. The story of the Fall in Genesis 3 discloses that immediately after Adam and Eve disobeyed God, something changed in their relationship with God. Discuss four aspects of sin's effects on man's relationship with God. Give Scriptural references. (10 marks)
2. Highlight and explain five main enemies of faith and how they can be overcome. (10 marks)
3. Discuss three reasons why the law cannot justify the believers. In your discussion, distinguish between justification and regeneration. (10 marks)
4. Explain in detail five factors of the assurance of glorification that arise out of the work of Christ as applied to believers. Give Scriptural references. (10 marks)
