1. a. Discuss *four* main approaches to mission which were practiced by Jesus and how they were adapted by the apostolic church. (10 marks)

b. Expound on the missiological connection between Genesis 1:28-30, Genesis 12:1-3 and Matthew 28:18-20 that scholars point out. (10 marks)
2. Describe using *five steps* how you can carry out sound contextualization among unreached people groups using biblical and theological arguments. (20 marks)
3. Analyze the entry of Christianity into West Africa in the 18- 19 century focusing on: two main leaders, two strategies used, and two main institutions for evangelization (20 marks).
4. Trace the entry of Christianity in South Africa by naming *three* missions involved, *three* strategies each employed, and the responses of the natives (20 marks).
5. Discuss *four* contributions to missions by *each* of the following African ministers: William Wade Harris and Simon Kimbangu and their implications for African mission theology. (20 marks)
6. Identify five qualifications for missionaries and evaluate how they impact the missionary career. (20 marks)
