SECTION ONE: Compulsory Questions. (30 Marks)

1. Jesus is the greatest preacher that has ever lived. Using His model, discuss the principles that define a Biblical preacher. **(7 Marks).**
2. Discuss the six strategies for an integrated exegetical hermeneutics. Explain key principles in each strategy and their significance to Biblical homiletics. **(8 Marks)**
3. Based on Revelation 2:8-11, prepare a written expository sermon giving details of your subject, theme, introduction, proposition, illustrations, and conclusion. Support your arguments with relevant Scriptures as need be. **(15 Marks)**

SECTION TWO: Answer any three Questions (ONLY) in this Section. (30 Marks)

1. Provides the Biblical and theological authority for preaching and teaching in the educational ministry of the Church. **(10 Marks)**
2. Based on your reading of Richard Baxter's book, "The Reformed Pastor"; discuss the role of the Pastor to self and the flock. **(10 Marks).**
3. Feminist interpretation of the Bible is rooted in the feminist critical consciousness that women and men are fully human and fully equal. This consciousness is opposed to teachings and sections that reinforce the social system that oppresses women and other groups in society. Do you agree with the affirmation of this critical consciousness? In the light of Ephesians 5:21- 33 and Galatians 3:28-29, interpret 1 Timothy 2:9-15 so that it is less offensive to the feminist consciousness. **(10 Marks)**
4. Discuss the role of the Holy Spirit in sermon preparation and delivery; stating how pastors / ministers can co-work with Him in ensuring proper "feeding of the flock". **(10 Marks)**
