4. Examine Paul's understanding of the Church as the Body of Christ. Discuss how this metaphor shapes his ecclesiology and guides his ethical exhortations in Ephesians and 1 Corinthians **(10 Marks)**.

5. Evaluate Paul's missionary strategy and theology as revealed in the Pauline Epistles. Outline insights that can be drawn for missions and evangelism in a pluralistic world **(10 Marks)**.
