SECTION A: 20 Marks

Answer ALL questions in this section.

1. Man is created in the image and likeness of God (Gen. 1:26). Differentiate the terms "image" and "likeness". (2 marks)
2. Distinguish between correct and incorrect implications of the doctrine of total depravity. Give two examples of each. (4 marks)
3. State and explain three biblical symbols of sin which are three enemies of man. Give Scriptural references. (3 marks)
4. Explain any three theories of atonement. In each theory give the main idea, its truth, and its weakness. (3 marks)
5. A fourfold picture of Christ's saving work is illustrated by four words which express distinct facets of salvation in Christ. Using an oval shape diagram, illustrate these words and their relationship with God. (4 marks)
6. Distinguish between justification from sanctification. (4 marks)

SECTION B (20 MARKS)

Answer ANY two questions in this section.

1. Based on biblical accounts, it is clear that man is very different from all other creatures. There is indeed a very big gap between the most ordinary human being and the most intelligent animal. No other creature can compare with man. State and explain four ways in which man is unique. By stating and explaining four aspects of man's uniqueness, prove a person who equates man to an animal to be wrong. Give scriptural references. (10 marks)
2. God's intention for human beings was to live in harmonious and meaningful relationships but sin has destroyed that harmony. Discuss three factors that mark the effects of sin in man's relationship with others. With scriptural references, explain why these factors are wrong for a Christian. (10 marks)
3. Discuss five benefits of faith. Give Scriptural references in each benefit. (10 marks)
4. Highlight the results of adoption and apply the message in your life and ministry. Give Scriptural references. (10 marks)
