1. (a) According to Matthew 24:3-31, great changes will occur among nations (wars), physical signs (earthquakes and tsunamis), and social treachery (one person betraying another). Discuss how the church should view these crises (**10 Marks**)
- (b) In the context of 1 Corinthians 9:19, clearly explain to a Muslim the paradox of being “free in Christ” at the same time making yourself a slave (**10 Marks**).

2. Evaluate the statement: “Most Africans resent orthodox Muslims.” Explain how African Muslims tend to differ from Orthodox Muslims (**10 Marks**).
3. Professor Gene Getz believes that Paul’s epistles teach that the church must have a balance among three elements: evangelism, discipleship, and fellowship (Getz, 152-153). Justify the need for each of these elements in the church-planting process and why these three elements need to be kept in balance (**10 Marks**).
4. Justify the statement, “The core of the gospel message is the forgiveness of sins in Jesus’ name,” to those who insist on teaching all the doctrinal teachings of the church in their approach to Muslims (**10 Marks**).
5. On your way back home after a crusade, you meet a Muslim and he engages you at length.
 - (a) Explain to him how to perceive the need for the cross (**5 Marks**)
