**SECTION A: COMPULSORY QUESTIONS** [answer all] 30 marks

1. You are elected Governor in the next general elections, and your first assignment is to deal with traffic jam within your first hundred days in office. Use Bloom Taxonomy as a critical thinking tool for solving the traffic jam problem in your county. [15marks]
2. You have a friend who believes God does not exist. In your attempt to convince them of God's existence, you tell them about the Triangle Analogy as follows: "Imagining God to not exist is like imagining a five sided triangle. Once you grasp the meaning of 'triangle', you realize that it is absurd to speak of one with five sides. If the shape you are imagining can have five sides, you are not imagining a triangle. The concept of 'triangle' demands that the shape have only three sides. Similarly, if you are imagining a being that might or might not exist, you are not imagining God, because the very concept of God demands existence". However, your friend remains incredulous. Then you decide to use Thomism as a theory to defend God's existence. How would you then defend the truth about the existence of God using Aquinas' Five Ways? [15marks]

5. List and provide two examples for each of the laws of logic. [10marks]

In other words, Christian worldview is a comprehensive view of the world from a biblical standpoint comprised of a number of distinct biblical elements.
