 - ii. Many times Youth Pastors are reluctant to forge a strategic alliance with parents. Enumerate the three assumptions that cause this reluctance. [3 marks]
 - iii. As a wise youth worker, Pastor Omari is seeking to be a good steward of opportunity and resources. He recognizes that evaluation is an essential discipline. Enumerate five reasons why one would resist evaluation. [5 marks]
