Analyze the best type of transmission media you would recommend for a reliable communication in such an industrial setting. **[3 marks]**

- d) You have a small office space that requires a cost-effective and easy-to-install transmission medium for connecting computers and printers within close proximity. The office space is already equipped with existing infrastructure, including walls and ceilings. Advise and justify the transmission media type you would suggest for this scenario. **[3 marks]**
